

 The Idaho Center is about 14 miles outside of Boise in Nampa. The venue is extremely easy to find and it is practically in the middle of nowhere. Take Exit 38-Garity Blvd (the sign will say "Idaho Center"). Turn left after the exit if coming from the west. You can't see the Idaho Center until you get onto the exit and down to the stoplight and turn left. The Idaho Center is maybe a half-mile/highway it is much easier to see because you've lost the hill that was blocking your view. There is a huge, free parking lot right next to it.

 Rose Garden is a flexible, multi-purpose facility that hosts a variety of events. From I-5 N or S, take one of the Rose Quarter Exits and follow signs. From I-84 Westbound, take Rose Quarter/Lloyd District Exit and continue straight, follow signs.
